2015 Highlights

1. Support for Nursing: This year Uganda Partners helped facilitate two major contributions to UCU's Nursing Program. We received a \$25,000 grant from the Westwood Endowment that will help the department integrate community nursing outreach into the bachelor's level curriculum, provide scholarships for bachelor's and master's students and ensure that UCU maintains laboratory excellent facilities. addition, a generous donor established an endowed nursing scholarship with a donation of \$25,000 in 2015 and a commitment for another \$25,000 donation in 2016.

- **2. Scholarship Support**: UCU Partners sent nearly \$180,000 scholarship funds to UCU in 2015 for students in all academic areas.
- **3. First Global 5K Event**:Our first Global 5K included 180 participants from 4 countries and 17 different US States. Our objective with the Global 5K is to run (literally and figuratively) an

annual event that will raise awareness about UCU, as well as raise funds for scholarships and projects.

- **4. First Art Contest**: As an example of ways we hope to build symbiotic partnership with UCU, we hosted an art contest with the art department at UCU. We used one of the final pieces in our communications this year.
- **5. Pilot Writing Center**: This new program is aimed at increasing the writing capacity of top UCU undergraduate students with an eye towards helping them gain admissions to top graduate programs. Not only will the Writing Center assist students, but it will supply more training and resources to UCU instructors who are teaching writing courses to undergraduate students.
