A firm foundation

Founded and owned by the Church of Uganda (Anglican).

Created in 1997 as a full university on the grounds of historic Bishop Tucker Theological College, which was founded in 1913

Building for a bright future

Accreditation: The first private university in Uganda to be fully accredited (chartered) by the government

Curriculum: Over sixty programs in theology, business, education, law, social science, health, engineering, information technology, and agriculture

Five campuses: The main campus at Mukono plus four regional campuses.

Enrollment: 11,000 students from 13 countries

Graduates: 15,000 from 1997-2012, with 100,000 projected by 2030

Christian identity

Committed to its Christian identity, firmly upholding Jesus Christ in lives and education through vibrant chaplaincy and mission programs. All students study Bible, ethics, world view, health and wholeness.
